School Readiness

School readiness is difficult to define. It is more than knowing your ABCs or being able to count to 20. Children's readiness can be assessed across 3 general areas:

Physical Well-Being and Motor Development: Children will have developed fine motor skills (cutting, dressing self), gross motor skills (running, jumping), and will be well-rested and well-nourished.

Social and Emotional Development: Children will be able to have positive interactions with others and be able to self-regulate their behavior as well as understand and express their feelings. They will also be able to solve conflicts, empathize with others and have the ability to take turns and share.

Cognitive and Language Development: Children will be able to observe, ask questions, and solve problems based on what they see and hear. They will have an enthusiastic and curious approach to new activities. Children will also be able to communicate with others and understand that there is a connection between letters and sounds.

What is the link between Quality Child Care and School Readiness?

There is a wealth of research and data that connect high-quality early childhood experiences to children's school readiness and later life success (see related research below). Research findings include:

- Improved school readiness skills
- Improved math and language ability
- Fewer cognitive and social issues
- Fewer behavior issues
- Less likely to be in special education
- Less likely to repeat a grade
- Less likely to enter juvenile detention programs
- More likely to graduate from high school
- More likely to be in a high-skilled job or higher education at age 21
- Less likely to commit a crime or felony
- Less likely to rely on social assistance programs (e.g., TANF, food stamps, housing)

Carrot and Zucchini Bars with Lemon Cream Cheese Frosting

- 2 eggs, slightly beaten
- 3/4 cup packed brown sugar
- 1/2 cup canola oil
- 1/4 cup honey
- 1 tsp vanilla
- 1 1/2 cups shredded carrot
- 1 cup shredded zucchini
- 1/2 cup chopped walnuts
- 1 1/2 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 tsp baking powder
- 1/2 tsp ground ginger
- 1/4 tsp baking soda

Lemon Cream Cheese Frosting

- 1 (8 oz) pkg reduced fat cream cheese
- 1 cup powdered sugar
- 1 1/2 tsp lemon zest

1.Preheat oven to 350 degrees F. In a large bowl, whisk together the eggs, brown sugar, oil, honey, and vanilla. Don't worry about clumps of the brown sugar, those will dissolve as it sits while you prepare the remaining ingredients. Then fold in the carrot, zucchini, and walnuts

2.In another bowl combine add the flour, baking powder, ginger, and baking soda. Whisk to blend together.

3.Add to flour mixture to the wet mixture. Stir just until combined. Spread batter into an ungreased 13x9x2-inch baking pan.

4.Bake about 25 minutes or until a toothpick inserted in center comes out clean. Cool completely in pan on a wire rack.

5.Once the cake is cooled prepare the frosting. In a medium mixing bowl, beat the frosting ingredients with an electric mixer on medium speed until fluffy. Spread or pipe the frosting over the cooled bars. Makes 36 bars.

Ice Cream in a Baggie:

| 1/2 cup milk | 1/4 cup half and half |
| 1 Tbsp sugar | 1/4 tsp vanilla extract |
| 1 gallon size Zip Bag | 2 sandwich size bags |
| 2 cups ice, 1 Tbsp rock salt | |

Pour all the ingredients into one of the small baggies (but ice and salt). Then put it into the second small baggie and Zip tight again. The second baggie here is to prevent the rock salt or ice from getting into the ice cream if the baggie comes open. Then ice and rock salt to the large bag. Place the small bags inside the large and seal. Now let the kids shake themselves silly. It can take 15-20 minutes of fairly vigorous shaking, so gloves are a good choice. I used my oven mitts and all your students to bring some from home. Let out some of the water that is formed as you go.


